The FEMA Structural Collapse Technician program is an advanced level program, designed to provide senior level responders with the knowledge, skills and abilities necessary to safely respond and function within a structural collapse, urban search and rescue environment.

The program requires successful completion of three blocks of training with a field evaluation exercise on the last day.

Block 1 US&R Shoring

Topics will include: scene safety, building materials, structural systems, collapse patterns, hazard identification, building monitoring, US&R response strategy, structural size-up, shoring basics and shoring construction.

Block 2 US&R Lifting and Rigging Heavy Objects

Topics will include: mass and gravity, mechanics and energy, moment of force, inclined planes, levers, pulley systems, "A" frame gantry, high-pressure air bags, cribbing, weight calculations, and the rigging of heavy objects.

Block 3 US&R Breaching/Breaking/Cutting and Burning

Topics will include: identification of concrete construction, types and components, equipment selection and use, proper techniques necessary to breach, break, cut and burn to gain access through concrete, steel and concrete structures.

- Required PPE: Steel-toed boots, helmet, leather gloves, eye protection, hearing protection, coveralls or long pants and long sleeve shirts.
- Optional PPE: Rain gear, warm coat, hydration pack, sun screen, bandanna, personal nail pouch, hammer, tape measure, camera and a second pair of boots if not water proof.
- Hours: 80

Upcoming Curriculum Changes

The Fire Academy has released its new Fire Officer II program on a limited schedule as outlined in the catalog insert. This five-day program meets the requirement of NFPA 1021, at the Officer II level.

Two other curriculum projects in the making without any confirmed release dates are: course 3316 - Rope Rescue High Angle. This 24-hour program will include knots, compound mechanical advantage systems, high angle haul systems, high angle lowering, belaying a falling load, high angle rappelling and vertical ascending. Completion of this course along with the prerequisite course 3310 will meet the requirements of Rope Rescue High Angle Level I of NFPA 1006.

The Fire Academy is also looking at the release of an 8-hour stand-alone course for hazardous materials awareness level. This will allow the Fire Academy to keep the delivery of the hazardous materials operations level at three days.



What Is Dual Path Testing?

Dual Path Testing is a term you will be hearing and reading about more in the coming months. It is not a new term nor is it a new concept for the Fire Academy. We have been using it for years with certain courses in which we offer certification. Dual Path Testing allows the academy to provide a student with a non-certification exam at the end of the course instead of the State Certification Exam (IFSAC). Completion of all practical or hands-on skills will still be required at the end of the course during the evaluation period. The non-certification exam requires as much preparation and studying as the certification exam does. The main difference is that it is concentrated on what was actually taught during the training sessions from the instructor's lesson plan. A certification exam may contain questions dealing with the entire national standard or from anywhere in the student manual, thus testing the student's ability to apply the standard. A certification exam requires a great deal of study time, and in some cases, studying other reference materials prior to taking the exam. This time is not always available in a three- to five-day delivery time for certain courses.

Two prime examples in our current curriculum are the driver-operator series and the hazardous materials areas. Students currently seeking certification for Driver Operator-Pumper must take courses 1210, 1220 and 1221. At the end of each of these courses, they must pass an end-of-course exam and the practical skills required at that level. Once they have all three courses and are certified by IFSAC or NPQS at the Firefighter I level, they may register after 30 days and no more than 180 days to challenge the certification for Driver Operator - Pumper. In the hazardous materials area, student's seeking certification in Hazardous Materials - Operator Level must successfully complete courses 1136 and 2722. Once this is done, they can challenge the state certification exam accredited by IFSAC. They only need to challenge the written exam since all practical skills have been completed successfully at this point.

So what is the main advantage? It is the amount of preparation and study time student's now have. They can review all the course material at their pace, the national standard itself and when they are ready, register for the challenge exam.

Some departments require their firefighters to have state certification through IFSAC and so they must continue on. If a student wishes not to continue and seek certification level for their training, they can stop after the course(s) applicable to the national standard and they can consider themselves trained to that level. The student will not be certified at that level but they have been trained to that level. The final decision will be made by the AHJ on what level they will accept.



Currently the Fire Academy offers Dual Path Testing for the following courses:

We are looking at offering Fire Officer II as a dual path testing course as well.

The state certification exam will continue to be at the end of the course exam for the following:

- Firefighter I
- Firefighter II
- Fire Instructor I
- Fire Officer I
- Aircraft Rescue Firefighter
- Fire and Life Safety Educator I

The Academy also offers an additional five levels of certification through the Challenge Program only. Refer to page 73 of the Curriculum Catalog for more details. These courses are:

Preparing for a Practical Certification Exam

Practical certification exams are conducted at the conclusion of certain courses. The Firefighter I Practical Certification Exam is conducted at the conclusion of course *1153 - NFPA Firefighter I*. The Firefighter II Practical Certification Exam is conducted at the conclusion of course *1154 - NFPA Firefighter II*; the *1002 - Driver/Operator-Pumper* practical exams are given at the conclusion of courses *1220 - Pump Operations I*, *1221 - Pump Operations II* and course *1210 - Emergency Vehicle Driver Training*; the practical exam for Instructor I is conducted at the end of course *4171 - Fire Instructor I*.

Based on this evaluation method, these courses are prerequisites to completing the written certification examination. Students who are successful in the course should be well prepared to take the practical skills exam. However, since the practical skills examinations contain several objectives, which they may be asked to perform, students should be prepared to perform all of the manipulative or practical objectives listed in the NFPA standard for that certification level. All practical skills tests are graded on a pass/fail system with a passing score required for successful completion of the certification exam. Passing means the student performed the skill correctly, while failing means the student performed the skill unsafely or to the point of being ineffective. Each student will be given two attempts to perform each required skill during the same test session. Should the student not receive a pass rating on the initial attempt, he/she will be eligible for an immediate second attempt. Students will be retested only on the skill that was not performed satisfactorily after two attempts. One retest opportunity is allowed for students failing to meet the minimum score for a practical skills exam. Any student failing to complete the second attempt will be required to retest the failed skill at a later date. The student must wait at least 30 days before retesting. Failing the retest means that the student must retake the training program before being eligible for retesting again.

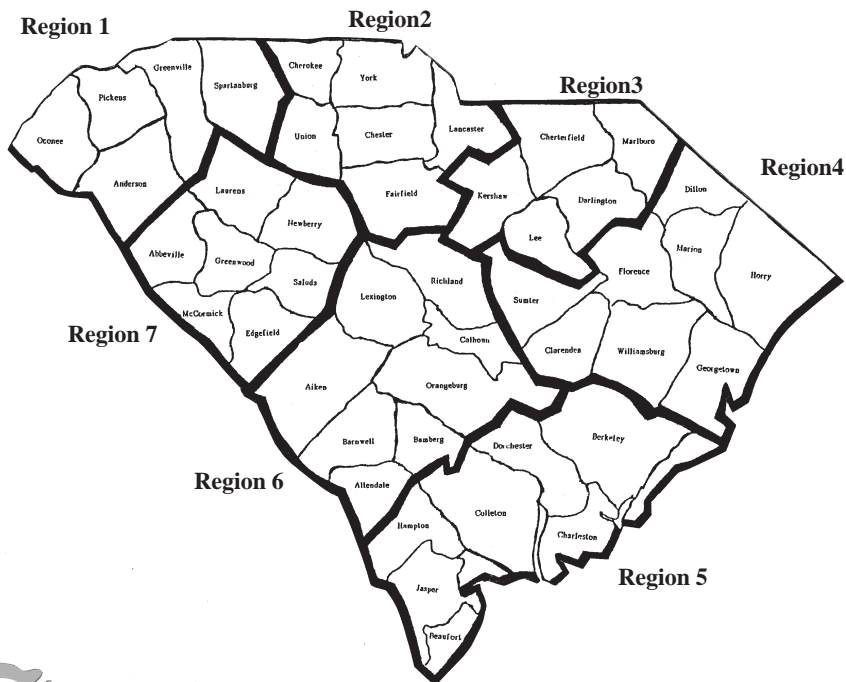
